- Home to a unique Alternative Twilight Program for students transitioning from Out-of-District placements.
- Hosts a Prom for Medically and Multiply Disabled Students every year.

- 17 students selected into Honors Chorus or All South Jersey Music Honors. Home of the NJ Division III Jazz Champion Ensemble.
- Home to a Courier Post Girls Basketball Coach of the Year, SJ Track Coaches Association Coach of the Year, Wrestling Coach of the Year, and Boys Cross County Coach of the Year.
- Highland was home to the Cross Country South Jersey Group II Champions and the Wrestling District 30 and Conference Champions.
- Timber Creek won Olympic Conference titles in Football, Girls Basketball and Girls Soccer.
- Partnership with Camden County College in a S.T.E.A.M.
   Academy, where students can earn college credits while in High School in unique Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, & Mathematics courses.
- Offer 4 core Fine Arts Programs in Dance, Music (both vocal & Instrumental), Art, and Theatre. One of only four in Camden County to offer all four Fine Arts Programs.

- Facility upgrades that include greater school security, Highland stadium bleachers, new Triton lockers, Highland roof, new parking surfaces, and outside student spaces.


#### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS & PREVENTION**




