

The following information must be provided before the student can be registered as a student within the Black Horse Pike Regional School District. Please make sure you bring all the items required.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY

- Driver's License or other photo identification: Must reflect the current address within the district.
- ❖ <u>Lease or renting residence:</u> If renting an apartment or other property, please provide a signed copy of the lease agreement. Two current utility bills (gas, electric, water, etc.) which show your name and the address will also be required.
- * Recent purchase of your new home: Signed and dated settlement papers reflecting the new address are required. Two current utility bills (gas, electric, water, etc.) which show your name and the address will also be required.
- ❖ If you own your home: Two current utility bills or one utility bill and a tax bill which reflect your name and address.
- **!** If you and the student live with someone within our district: An Affidavit of Residency is required. This form must be completely filled out and notarized.
 - •The parent or guardian must provide proof of residency for this address, including a driver's license and / or other photo id and two forms of official mail.
 - •The resident must provide proof of residency as stated above.
 - •You and the resident must appear at the time of registration.
 - •If only the student is living with someone in our district, legal guardianship or court ordered custody documents are required.

STUDENT INFORMATION

- ❖ The student must be formally withdrawn from his/her previous school before registering at BHPRSD. Please provide formal withdrawal form and copies of student's transcipts, attendance records, test scores, report cards and schedule from previous school
- Please provide an official copy of the student's immunization records.
- Please provide original birth certificate reflecting parent's names.
- Please provide court ordered custody papers, guardianship papers, or placement letter in cases of guardianship, group home placements, and / or foster children.
