The Class of 2026 starting **JUNIOR** their year!! Our Triton family is committed to helping our students have an enriching and memorable experience throughout high school. Out of all of the programs, services, and support we offer here at Triton, we take special pride in the activities we sponsor for our seniors. Although it may seem far away, your senior year will be here before you know it and we want to make it possible for you to enjoy everything we have to offer.

This letter is to remind you of an option available to our students to help space out the costs of senior year; the **SENIOR EXPENSE ACCOUNT** or S.E.A. The purpose of the S.E.A. is to help you successfully manage the payments needed for all of the exciting Class of 2026 events we have in store senior year. Using the recommended depositing dates and amounts, you will be well on your way to affording all of these great opportunities that are ahead.

Foremost on the list is the Triton Class of 2026 Senior Trip to Orlando, Florida. **The trip is traditionally scheduled in March. The cost for the trip for the class of 2025 is approximately \$1900 and we anticipate that price to increase.** The cost includes transportation, hotel stay, 2 daily meals each day, park tickets, and all transfers to and from parks. Trip details will be finalized by March of Junior year (2025). A recommended payment schedule has been created to help spread out estimated costs.

### **Making deposits in the S.E.A is beneficial for a few reasons:**

- Start-and-keep- a steady payment schedule for the senior trip, therefore making it more affordable
- Pay for Senior prom tickets, t-shirts, cap & gown, Senior yearbook, and other class related expenses in the senior year by drawing on the S.E.A. account at any time, provided the funds are available in your account

### **Please note, the S.E.A CANNOT be used to pay for the following items:**

- Lunch
- Book fines
- Field Trips
- Gym Uniforms
- Homecoming tickets
- Athletic events
- Class rings
- Students who leave Triton prior to senior year or are not eligible to participate in senior events will forfeit money **earned** and it will be rolled over into the Class of 2026 general account.

We are offering individual fundraisers that can be added to the S.E.A. account. This year we are offering the Phillies ticket fundraiser again. Students can earn money from each ticket sold for their S.E.A. We intend to continue this fundraiser next year as well. # Suggested (not mandatory) Trip Payment Schedule

\*\*This schedule is just recommended as a way to make payments more manageable.

\*For students who do not wish to make early payments, the anticipated payments due dates set by the travel company will be **mandatory** deposit amounts.

At this time, payments will only be accepted in the form of a check or money order. Checks will only be collected during the school year, **Any payments made by check or money order must be payable to Triton High School. Cash will not be accepted.** The student's name and "2026 Trip" must be on the memo line. Payments can be made in Mr. Ambrose's office (B-8) during "Mustang Time". Please save your receipts. Early payments may be made as frequently as you wish; however, we ask that the minimum of each payment is \$100. **By September 15<sup>th</sup> 2025**, students must have a **minimum of \$600 deposited to reserve a spot**. We will also be offering individual fundraising opportunities for students to offset the cost of the various senior activities, including Senior Trip. If your child is unable to attend the trip, payments will be refunded in accordance with the travel agent's policy. **Money raised through fundraising can be used for other senior activities here at Triton (yearbook, prom, cap and gown, etc.) but cannot be refunded to the student or transferred to any other school.**

**Payments will not be accepted for students on Principal's Probation for discipline, academic reasons, attendance issues, or if they have outstanding fines.**

**Refund policy:** If you have been making payments but decide not to go on the trip, payments are completely refundable until October 1, 2025. (subject to change, as determined by travel company based on date of trip). Any time thereafter, any payments you have made will only be reimbursed to the extent allowable by World Class Vacations and/or cancellation policies. For this reason, **purchasing trip insurance will be mandatory when the information becomes available.**
