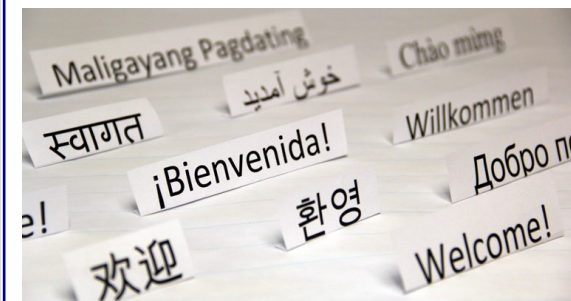

ELL INSTRUCTION

- All students, including ELL students receive instruction that complies with the laws of the State of New Jersey and the requirements established by the Board of Education

In sheltered instruction, teachers use the core curriculum but modify it to meet the language development needs of English language learners. ELL students are mainstreamed for all other academic and elective courses.

ENROLLMENT IN THE ELL PROGRAM

- Students who speak or hear a language other than English in their home are eligible for placement.
- Student language proficiency will be assessed and based on results, a recommendation for placement will be made by the district.



GOALS OF THE ELL PROGRAM

- Provide English instruction in speaking, listening, reading, and writing.
- Provide access to the Black Horse Pike Regional School District's curriculum and all of its educational benefits.
- Support the social and cultural development of students.

GRADUATION

To obtain a diploma, the following requirements must be met by all students:

- Pass the PARCC assessment or one of the NJDOE standardized assessments and End of Course Assessments (i.e., Biology).
- Earn a total of 120 credits (130 credits for the Class of 2018 and beyond).
- Pass the following courses:
 - 4 years of Physical Education
 - 4 years of Health
 - 4 years of English
 - 1 year of World History/Cultures
 - 2 years of U.S. History
 - 3 years of Math
 - 3 years of Laboratory Science
 - 1 year of World Language
 - 1 year of Visual/Performing Arts
 - 1 year of 21st Century Life & Careers, or Career-Technical Education
 - ½ year of Financial, Business, & Economic Literacy

- Complete the English Research Paper.
