

COVID Protocols for 23-24 School Year

If we are made aware that your student is positive for COVID-19:

- They are to be excluded from school for five days from the onset of their symptoms. They can return on day six. Masking is recommended.
- To have the days excused, you must provide a picture of the positive home test, doctor's note, or an official test result from a lab with the student's name on it.
- State regulations deem that any student who is absent more than twenty days from school, whether excused or unexcused will be considered on "No credit Status". They may be required to appear before the Principal with his/her parent(s) or guardian(s) to appeal their absence and may lose credit for the school year, if absences are excessive or no documentation is available to support extenuating circumstances.
