

Facilities Committee Meeting Report

1. Asbestos Abatement at Highland – Garrison is still trying to finalize the costs. This project will start at the end of the school year.
2. Security Camera Installation Project- Garrison is still trying to finalize the costs of this project as well. This project will start at the end of the school year.
3. ADA Compliant Bathroom Trailer – Joe is investigating obtaining this type of facility for the TC athletic area. Leasing is an option that will be considered. Pricing for purchasing as well as leasing are being worked on.
4. Highland Bleachers and Press Box – The committee discussed the various options for the bleachers. Currently the home bleachers seats about 1188 and the visitors seats about 430. The new planned home bleachers seats about 840, has a press box, ramp, and handicap accessible area. The visitors' side would have approximately 400 seats. The bleachers will not go as high as the current bleachers, and therefore not require the elevator. They will be longer than the current bleachers.
5. Highland Tennis Courts – The tennis courts have cracks in sections. Joe will contact the engineer who designed them to try to get this issue resolved.
6. Highland roof, second floor – Leaks have been cropping up and need to be addressed. Garrison will have Gantor review the roof next week and propose a solution. This may be a coating to the roof and have a 5 year warranty. We have past experience with Gantor, and they have completed their jobs timely and without issue.
