5465 EARLY GRADUATION (M)

The Board of Education will award a State endorsed diploma to a student that has met all State and local requirements for high school graduation. In addition, the Board shall award a State endorsed high school diploma to any currently enrolled student in accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 6A:8-5.2(e).

In accordance with the provisions of N.J.A.C. 6A:8-5.2(e), the Board of Education shall a State-endorsed high school diploma early to any currently enrolled student who:

1.	Has demonstrated proficiencies in the Statewide assessments as
	required by the New Jersey Department of Education for high
	school graduation;
2.	Has presented official transcripts showing at least thirty general
	education credits leading to a degree at an accredited institution of
	higher education; and
3.	Has formally requested an early award of a State-endorsed high

school diploma.

The diploma will bear the date of its issuance. The student may be permitted to participate in graduation ceremonies with his/her classmates without formal readmission to the school district on application to and approval of the high school Principal.
