

**RESOLUTION OF THE BLACK HORSE PIKE REGIONAL BOARD OF EDUCATION  
DISQUALIFYING HERNAN GOLDNER AND AWARDING CONTRACT FOR THE  
TIMBER CREEK CONTROL SYSTEM REPLACEMENT TO BRADLEY-  
SCIOCCHETTI, INC.**

**WHEREAS**, the Black Horse Pike Regional Board of Education (“the Board”) awarded a contract for the Timber Creek Control System Replacement (“the project”) to Herman Goldner, Co., Inc., the apparent low bidder on the project, on June 24, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, a bid protest was subsequently filed by the second low bidder, Bradley-Sciocchetti, Inc., raising issues regarding the bid of Herman Goldner, Co., Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the Business Administrator/Qualified Purchasing Agent, along with the Board’s Engineer, Remington & Vernick Engineers, have reviewed the contents of the bid protest, and upon their further investigation, concur with its contents; and

**WHEREAS**, the Business Administrator/Qualified Purchasing Agent has disqualified Hernan Goldner, Co., Inc. due to non-compliance with material bid specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, the Business Administrator/Qualified Purchasing Agent substituted the next qualified bidder, Bradley-Sciocchetti, Inc., in order to expedite the project due to time constraints.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Black Horse Pike Regional Board of Education, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, to retroactively approve to June 30, 2021 the disqualification of Herman Goldner, Inc., and approval of Bradley-Sciocchetti, Inc. for the Timber Creek Control System Replacement project.
