 - For those students who may be discipline problems
 - For those who have difficulty in the high school setting
 - For those who need OMC... "One more Chance".
- Schools in participation were mentioned... Overbrook, Deptford, Winslow
 Mostly 11 & 12 grade
- Cost: \$8,000 per year, with summer school included
- Application process was explained
- Certified and fingerprinted teachers and one aid are in the room
- MWF: English and Social Studies, T&R: Math and Science
- Ability to walk in graduation is up to the school district.
- Parent orientation meetings are in August
- If there is a fight in the room, the students are disciplined by suspensions.
- Issues that were brought up that need to be answered... We have Safety in mind first and foremost... then curriculum.
