Dr. Repici presented the following items:

- 1. Personnel
 - a. **Example threatened suicide and the police were contacted.** will be on administrative leave until cleared by a medical doctor.
 - b. A Timber Creek teacher inappropriately texted a recent 17 year old graduate. Mr. Wade discussed details of the situation. Additional questions by the Board were answered by Mr. Wade and/or Dr. Repici.
- 2. Superintendent and Board Goals
