- **Affirmation Box** –Messages of affirmation will be available to students. The affirmations will be a reminder of their ability to make positive choices.
- **Classroom/Curriculum** - Incorporating positive messages of respect and tolerance into the classroom. Encouraging classrooms and departments to promote the message of respect throughout the week in their lessons.
- **MOTIVATIONAL QUOTES**: Announced over the PA daily.
- **SPEAKER JOE CONLIN**: Joe Conlin who is the director of Prevention Plus and has a background in law enforcement. The presentation for Triton will be on Oct 21, 2013 and Jen Brown will be coordinating this effort with us and her health educators for the classroom presentations. Joe will be here most of the day trying to speak in as many health classes as can be fit in. He engages the students on the dangers of substance abuse and inherent violence associated with substance abuse, and in this regard he will also be covering red ribbon week themes as well. In addition, Joe shows a short film and pulls on his own professional police background to deliver his prevention and drug and alcohol message.
- **SADD CLUB**: Sac bulletin board, posters, and front lobby showcase provide respect and violence awareness themes.

- **The Pledge** – Students are singing a pledge to respect themselves and others



School Violence Awareness Week
October 21st – 25th, 2013

The theme “I am Worthy” will carry through the entire month of October.

An “I am...” video created with the help of SADD Club will air every Monday in October and various PSAs from the Foundation for a Better Life will air on the Morning News and focus on school violence awareness and respect themes.

“Peace” bookmarks – These bookmarks will be distributed to students and staff on Monday, October 21, 2013.

Joe Conlin from Prevention Plus will be speaking to our Health classes on Wednesday, 10/23. He will address the dangers of substance abuse and the inherent violence associated with these choices.

World of Difference and SADD Club will do a showcase in the Main Lobby called “Be a Bucket Filler” to promote Week of Respect and School Violence Awareness Week.

Affirmation Box – Every VP office will have a box of affirmations. The affirmations will be a reminder of their ability to make positive choices.

There are a number of classrooms that will focus on lessons on tolerance, acceptance, and diversity. “Let ‘Em In” PSA will be shown in Driver’s Ed. classes to address road rage. Suggestions from TYA on HIB will be posted on the Shared Directory.

SADD Club and World of Difference will have bulletin boards relative to respect and school violence awareness.

2013 School Violence Awareness Week

October 21st – October 25th

- **Theme of the Month** – Timber Creek's theme, "Respect is Earned Not Given. Be Strong. Be Positive. Be a Role Model. Be a Charger." will carry throughout the month of October.
- **Bookmarks** – English teachers will distribute bookmarks to students during all classes. English teachers will also incorporate a Reader's/Writer's Notebook activity that coincides with the messages of anti-violence, respect, and tolerance. The bookmarks will be printed with Timber Creek's theme "Respect is Earned Not Given. Be Strong. Be Positive. Be a Role Model. Be a Charger." This activity will help bring awareness to violence in schools and encourage positive student interaction. Marcie Geyer, supervisor, has helped coordinate this effort.
- **PSA's** related to School Violence Awareness will be read on the Morning Announcements by students from theatre class. The PSAs will include violence awareness quotes and clips from the Foundation for a Better Life. With the help of Ms. Deich and Mr. McCoog, Timber Creek's "Respect Video" will be aired every Monday in the month of October. This video showcases students and faculty expressing a message of respect to the school.
- **Presentations** (Thursday, October 24, 2013) - Joe Conlin, law enforcement agent from Prevention Plus, will conduct 7 periods of presentations to all of Timber Creek's health classes. He will address the dangers of substance abuse and the inherent violence associated with these choices. Jennifer Brown, supervisor, has helped coordinate this effort.
- **Classroom/Curriculum** – There are a number of classrooms and departments that will be promoting the message of school violence awareness through lessons on violence, tolerance, acceptance, and diversity.
- **Youth Alliance Information/Resources** are distributed to all teachers as a resource for conflict resolution.
- **Hallways** – The SADD club will create posters and flyers to hang in the hallways to endorse school violence awareness and boost positive student interaction.
- **Affirmation Box** – The counseling office will distribute positive affirmations. Students will be reminded to select an affirmation when they leave the office. The affirmations will be a reminder of their ability to make positive choices.
