Dear Parent or Guardian,

Our district provides a Multilingual Learner (MLL), formerly English Language Learner (ELL) program for students who need instruction in English as a Second or Other Language (ESOL). This program is at Triton Regional High School. Based on a review of your Home Language Survey, your child’s academic records, and their score on an assessment of their English language skills, it has been determined that he/she is eligible for ESL services.

The MLL program offers a curriculum designed to teach students listening, speaking, reading, writing, viewing, and language skills necessary for success in high school and life. Participation in this program will help your child succeed academically. Although this program will benefit your student’s academic success, you, as a parent or guardian, have the right to decline these services being offered to your child. It must be understood however that your child’s academic progress may be limited should you decide against participation in this program.

If you do not wish your child to participate in this program, your signature on this document will reflect that your child is eligible for the program, that the benefits of the program have been clearly explained to you, and that you are declining these services. If this is your desire, please sign and return this letter to Mr. Francisco Olaya, Director of School Counseling at Triton Regional High School on 250 Schubert Avenue, Runnemede N.J. 08078. Please note that even though you chose to decline ESL services, your child must still take the annual WIDA ACCESS 2.0 test each Spring until they reach a state-mandated composite exit score of 4.5.
