The 4x400 team of **Daijah Davis-Hines, Christine Lavallias, Raven Williams and Sabehah Kane** took a respectable 5th place.

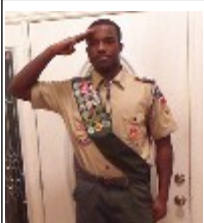
Cameron Allen took 3rd in the 2 mile

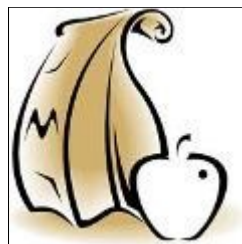
The course will give them a place to hold tournaments and entertain visitors.

CAREER DAY APRIL 19th

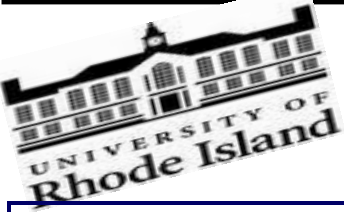
