Dear Parents and Caregivers,

After collaboration with the Board of Education, we are re-starting our hybrid, in-person learning schedule on Tuesday, January 19, 2021. For this week only, Group A students will attend in-person learning on Tuesday, January 19, and Wednesday, January 20. Group B will attend on Thursday, January 21, and Friday, January 22.

Thereafter, the half-day, in-person schedule remains the same as it was prior to the remote-learning model. Student groups would either go to school in-person on Monday and Tuesday or Thursday and Friday, between the hours of 7:25 am and 11:45 am. This is a half-day, in-person schedule, where four periods run each day. On the days where students do not see their class teacher in-person, but that class period still meets, students will log into their computer and participate in “live-streaming” instruction. Students will still be required to complete any assignments on Google classroom each day.

Teachers will offer remote extra-academic help to students after 12:35 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday.

ALL students will continue to log into their computers on Wednesday for remote, yet live, instruction, as it has been; the school day ends at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday.

Students who continue to learn remotely will participate in remote “streamed” instruction from the classroom teacher directly. Students learning remotely will be required to log into their classes each day, each period, at the direction of their teachers.

Morning transportation pick-up times remain the same. Students will be going to school two half-days a week. All students will exit the school at 11:45 am. The 1:00 pm athletic bus service will continue to transport students from home back to school, if students request this service through their vice-principal or their coach.
