Dear Parents and Guardians of Students with Special Needs and/or Parents of Students in the Referral Process.

We certainly hope that this notice finds you and your loved ones safe and healthy. While much of the landscape of what the future holds remains uncertain, we are writing to provide a brief update on special education plans and supports.

Child Study Team Meetings and Evaluations

We continue to successfully conduct Annual Review meetings via online platforms such as Google Meet/Hangout, ZOOM and Freeconferencecall.com. Additionally, we have conducted Reevaluation, Identification, and IEP review meetings.

The challenges of conducting evaluations during this time period have been significant. We have continued to conduct any assessments virtually, that were feasible to do so. We have postponed some assessments that require face to face interactions in order for the assessment results to be valid. As a result, we will continue to delay necessary evaluations until Governor Murphy relaxes social distance requirements that are preventing us from administering in-person evaluations. However, we have directed our CST to ensure that all students who are pending initial eligibility or reevaluations are not denied needed services based solely on our inability to complete evaluations. In these circumstances, our team, in collaboration with parents, will determine the need for specialized instruction where other sources of data demonstrate a clear need for specialized services. We will make every reasonable effort to provide those services in good faith until formal CST evaluations can be completed.

Progress Reports

IEP progress reports are now going to be available online effective June 1, 2020 via the Genesis Parent Portal for viewing. You will be able to access your child's progress reports by utilizing the same username and password you currently use to gain access into the parent portal. *Please note, this feature will replace the paper copy sent to your home.* If you would prefer to opt-out of this feature and continue to receive a paper copy mailed to your home each marking period, please email your request to opt-out the Child Study Team secretary in your child's school before May 28, 2020.
