

Class of 2020 Graduation Parade



Hello, Graduating Class of 2020. With the help of police departments, parents, fire departments, Black Horse Pike Regional School District Board of Education, and town mayors, we are hosting a parade in your honor to celebrate your accomplishments as you complete your high school education.

Dates (Rain or Shine):

Highland = June 22

Timber Creek = June 23

Triton = June 24

When Does It Start:

We will roll out of the respective High School Parking Lot at 6:30 p.m. sharp.

Where Do We Meet/Begin the Parade:

All cars will be lined up on a first-come, first in line basis at each High School. We will start lining up cars at 6:00 pm, 30 minutes before 6:30 pm. You will drive slowly in the parking lot and obey directions of personnel in the parking lot. You may not exit your vehicle during this time. Everyone is to stay in the vehicle you arrived in. There will not be bathrooms at the school for your use.

At Highland, vehicles will be lined up in the G Corridor lot, between Erial Road and Blackwood Clementon Road and snake around to the Erial Road side and into the raised parking lot near the softball field. We will exit the parking lot making a right onto Blackwood-Clementon Road.

At Timber Creek, vehicles will be lined up following the student parking lot (auditorium side) and snake around the school, all the way past the football field and the tennis courts. Vehicles will exit the staff parking lot side making a right onto Jarvis Road towards Sicklerville Road.

At Triton, vehicles will be lined up behind Cappelli Courtyard and exit out of Oak Avenue.

This is a school-sponsored event during a pandemic, so the police departments and the school board have asked that you follow these expectations.

Rules will be enforced by Gloucester Township, Runnemedede, and Bellmawr Police Departments.

1. Police Departments have determined the safest route to take. We will not be able to go past every house, apartment, neighborhood, or complex. That is why we are publishing the route in advance so people can choose to cheer you along the way. The police are

escorting us during this parade route, so make sure you are alert while driving your vehicle.

2. Social distancing of 6 feet between you and another person, not in your immediate family, will be enforced.
3. One vehicle per family is permitted. **If you or your family do not means of transportation, but would like to participate, please indicate so on the [survey](#).** We will try our best to get buses and bus drivers.
4. We prefer another licensed driver (adult), other than you, drive the car, if at all possible. We do not want you distracted by looking around during the parade.
5. You may not have more than two graduates in any one vehicle.
6. You may not jump from vehicle to vehicle. If police see you doing this, you will be pulled out and may face a fine for not following social distancing rules. Once you show up in a vehicle, you are to remain in that vehicle.
7. You may not take a convertible.
8. You must be in an enclosed vehicle. You may not take an ATV, motorcycle, or pick-up truck with chairs in the back.
9. You may not ride in the vehicle with your head and body through the sunroof/moonroof.
10. It is preferred, if possible with appropriate ventilation, that you keep your windows up. If you prefer to have your windows down, we prefer you have a face covering or mask of some sort.

Things to consider:


- You will receive streamers and window markers/paint when picking up your caps and gowns. You can choose to decorate your own vehicle if you want.
- This will be a lengthy parade, assuming many students participate, so make sure you go to the bathroom before leaving your house.
- This will be a lengthy parade, assuming many students participate, so make sure your vehicle has plenty of fuel and is in proper working order.
- Please adhere to the traffic routes, directions, and stoppages along the parade route.
- We will not return to the school at the end of the route.

Highland Parade Route -June 22, 2020, 6:30 pm


- Leave the school making a right onto Blackwood Clementon Rd.
 - Make a Right onto Little Gloucester Rd.
 - Make a Right onto Erial Rd. and pass in front of Lewis School.
 - Make a Left onto Davistown Rd.
 - Make a Right onto Rt. 168 and pass Gloucester Twp. School.
 - Make a Right onto Church St.
 - Make a Left onto Erial-Blenheim Rd. and pass Blackwood School and GT Schools Administration Building.
 - Make a Right onto Tice Ave and a Right onto Coles Rd.
 - Make a Left onto Little Gloucester Rd. passing Loring Flemming and Glen Landing Schools.
 - Make a Left onto Chews Landing Rd.
 - Make a Right onto Somerdale Rd. and pass Chews School.
- The procession ends on Somerdale Rd.



Timber Creek Parade Route June 23, 2020 - 6:30 pm

- Leave the school making a right onto Jarvis Rd.
- Make a Right onto Sicklerville Rd.
- Make a Right onto Garwood Rd.
- Make a Right onto Erial Rd. and onto Williamstown Rd. passing Lilley School.
- Make a Right onto Berlin Cross Keys Rd.
- Make a Right onto Sicklerville Rd. passing Mullen School.
- Make a Right onto Jarvis Rd. passing Union Valley School.

The procession ends on Jarvis Rd.



Triton Parade Route June 24, 2020 - 6:30 pm

1. Exit Oak Avenue
2. L onto Davis Road
3. L onto Schubert Avenue, past Triton High School
4. R onto Evesham, past St. Teresa Regional School
5. R onto Black Horse Pike

BELLMAWR POLICE & TRITON ROUTE

1. Black Horse Pike north to Anderson Ave (left), past Ethel Burke Elementary
2. Anderson Ave to Bell Rd (left), past Bell Oaks School
3. Bell Rd to W. Browning Rd (right)
4. W. Browning Rd to Victory Dr (left), past Bellmawr Park Elementary
5. Victory Dr to Peach Rd (right)
6. Peach Rd to Essex Ave (left)
7. Essex Ave to Creek Rd (left)
8. Creek Rd to W. Browning Rd
9. W. Browning Rd to Lowell Ave (right)
10. Lowell Ave to Benigno Blvd (left), past Ethel Burke Elementary
11. Benigno Blvd to the Black Horse Pike (right return)

TRITON & RUNNEMEDE ROUTE

1. R on Smith Lane
2. L on Hirsch
3. Take Hirsch across 3rd Avenue
4. R on Singley Ave.
5. L on 3rd Ave., past Volz Middle School
6. R onto Black Horse Pike


TRITON & GLOUCESTER TOWNSHIP ROUTE

1. L onto Chews Landing Road Rt. 683
2. Right onto Little Gloucester Road Rt. 759, past Glen Landing Middle School
3. R onto Coles Road
4. R onto Black Horse Pike
5. R onto Old Black Horse Pike
6. Cross over Chews Landing Road onto Somerdale Road
7. Once we past Chews Elementary School, the Parade Route ends.
