Dear Parents and/or Guardians,

At my request all coaches and advisors have established a common rule among their sports teams and groups. It will be explained to your child prior to the start of the season and included in their individual team and group rules. To ensure everyone communicates it as intended I am providing this letter for clarification.

- If a student receives a two to four school ANY reason they will be suspended for one game, match, or competition. This will be issued by the coach. **Second offenses will require a meeting with the coach/advisor, student and a member of administration before the student can resume participation.**
- If a student receives an Administrative Lunch Detention for any **misconduct, cutting class, leaving school without permission, insubordination, vandalism, bullying, harassment, intimidation, class disruption, misuse of a hall pass, cafeteria misconduct, or any type of disruptive-insubordinate behavior** a one game suspension will be issued by the coach. If they receive a detention under the category of "Other", it will be reviewed by the Principal and decided if a game or competition suspension is warranted. **Second offenses will require a meeting with the coach/advisor, student and a member of administration before the student can resume participation.**
- Smoking and possession of smoking items is a violation of the general participation policy and will be handled accordingly. This includes e-cigarettes and vapor items.
- Student-athletes who test positive or are in possession of illegal substances MAY not be eligible to participate in athletics.
- Student-athletes must be passing all classes prior to the start of the season and maintain passing grades throughout the season. **If an athlete is failing one or more classes they MAY be placed on Principal's probation with a plan to improve their academic standing. Student-athletes on Principal's probation may not be eligible to participate in their sport.**

As Principal, my goal is to have students make good choices. Our students who are involved must be POSITIVE ROLE MODELS, especially when they are wearing our uniforms.
