2019-2020 AP Exam Registration Process

Students planning to take an Advanced Placement Examination in May 2020 must do the following:

1. Register for the Spring 2020 AP exams using the attached form - no later than November 1, 2019.

If you receive free-reduced lunch, please make sure you check that off on the registration form.

NOTE: Students who register/pay for a test after November 1, 2019 will be required to pay a mandatory \$40.00 late fee on top of their regular registration fee.

2. Registration is open from October 16, 2019 - November 1, 2019.

NOTE: Students will be responsible for \$50 for each AP exam they register for in 2019-2020 (free-reduced lunch students pay \$25 per exam). In September of 2020 the BHP will refund your \$50 fee if you score a 3, 4 or 5 on the exam.

If you cancel your AP exam once they are ordered, there is a MANDATORY \$15 fee per exam. Cancellations can only be made with parental and teacher permission. The student must have their parent/guardian write a note and have it signed by the teacher.

- 3. Attend the pre-admission (TBD in April 2020) session.
- 4. Receive and review the AP Bulletin for Students & Parents.

School Counselors are available during Charger Time to assist with registrations if need be.

Below is information needed for May 2020. NOTE: $Scores \ge 3$'s will be refunded in the fall of 2020 **2020 AP fee per exam - \$50.00** (\$25 Free & Reduced). Cancellation fee - \$15.00 non-refundable

If you need a make-up test for any reason, the CollegeBoard charges a \$40 late fee per test. Check with your counselor for specific information.

The CollegeBoard will NOT waive the fee for the following reasons:

Illness, academic contests/events, athletic contests/events, conflict with non-AP exams, family commitments, ordering errors, other school events, school closing (local decision, non-emergency).
