## Dear Alum:

In 2020 Triton Regional High School lost an icon. Whether you knew him as Mr. Beaudet, Coach, Harry, or Mr. Triton, it is impossible to deny that Mr. Beaudet had a positive impact on the growth and development of thousands of students in the Black Horse Pike School District. Although retired since 1995, he continued to serve on committees such as the Triton Hall of Fame, the Triton Athletic Hall of Fame and professional committees related to South Jersey scholastic athletics and Rowan University. He continued to answer the call when institutional knowledge or an experienced hand was needed.

Mr. Beaudet taught, coached, and served as Athletic Director during his 37 years of service to Triton. During those years he was recognized by his students and colleagues as having a valuable voice in their lives and development as professionals. As a coach he was the master of the Zone Defense but in life his greatest contribution may have been his mastery of Person to Person (Man on Man) communication. His memory was legendary never forgetting a name, remembering every detail of events that happened years ago and often providing information of which you were unaware. If you were one of his students, he was available for a lifetime of guidance.

A group of his former students, athletes and colleagues have established a Not-For-Profit Corporation with 501C3 status to endow a scholarship in his name, The Harry Beaudet Scholarship Fund. The formal structure allows contributions to the scholarship fund to be tax exempt.

Each academic year scholarships of \$1000 will be rewarded to one female and one male Triton student who participated in either basketball, cross country or track and field. The recipients will be chosen by a committee of Triton staff in accordance with selection procedures used for other scholarships. Character will be used as the primary criteria for selecting a recipient, not skill, not athletic or academic prowess. The scholarships can be used to support the recipient's pursuit of a degree at either a 2-year or 4-college or a certified trade school.

If each team that Mr. Beaudet coached could provide a combined donation of \$2000 the resulting total would guarantee the ability of Triton to offer this tribute for a very long time. If applicable indicate which team and year that you would like your gift to represent. As the scholarship fund grows it is the hope that the amount of the award will be adjusted to meet the rising costs of education. In addition to his former teams it is hoped that friends, colleagues, and former students will be interested in supporting this recognition of his contribution to others.
