## Senior Parking Privilege Rules and Expectations - August 2021

Senior Parking is a **PRIVILEGE**. Parking passes will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. You must be in good academic standing, have earned senior status (minimum of 90 credits), and remain in good standing in both areas of discipline and attendance (please reference school policy on our website).

Decline in any of the above and the following may result in immediate removal of your privilege.

Applications must be completed via Google Form and require you to use your student email to send a picture of your driver's license, registration, and insurance card to Mrs. Cammarata at <a href="mailto:lcammarata@bhprsd.org">lcammarata@bhprsd.org</a>. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- **❖** Your parking permit must be visibly displayed on your rearview mirror at all times. There will be no replacement permits provided. Losing your parking permit will result in a loss of parking privileges.
- **❖** You must park in your assigned parking spot only. Your parking permit will align with your assigned, numbered parking space.
- **❖** You must obey the on-campus speed limit of 5 MPH. Speeding on property may result in loss of parking privileges.
- **❖** You must arrive at school on time. Once you accrue your fifth (5th) "late to school" you will lose your parking privilege for a minimum of 30 (thirty) days. Continued lateness may result in permanent loss of parking privileges.
- **A** Choosing to leave school grounds without permission will result in immediate and permanent loss of parking privileges.
  - **❖** Being placed on Principal's Probation, for any reason, will result in a loss of parking privileges for the time of your probation. Being placed on Principal's Probation repeatedly may result in a permanent loss of parking privileges.
- ❖ You must be passing all of your classes cumulatively after the first semester in order to maintain your parking privileges in the Spring.
- ❖ Parking on campus without a properly displayed parking permit or permission will be reported to the Runnemede Police Department and you may receive a ticket.
